**Abelia grandiflora “Edward Goucher” (Pink/Glossy Abelia)** This is a versatile, semi-evergreen shrub with mauvy pink flowers. The foliage turns bronze in fall and mature size is 1.5m T and W. **Zone 6**

**Abelia grandiflora “Conti” (Confetti Abelia)** This beautiful very slow growing variety features variegated green and white foliage. Mature size is 70cm T x 1.5m W. **Zone 6**

**Acer palmatum ‘Bloodgood’** Deep purple-red large leaf, upright form with a rounded canopy; fall foliage red; blackish-red bark; filtered sun; height and spread 5.5m **Zone 5**

**Acer palmatum ‘Butterfly’** Its variegated light green foliage with cream and pink edge leaves. It is a slow growing maple that can reach 15 feet (4.5m) when mature. **Zone 5**

**Acer palmatum ‘Kagiri Nishiki’** This upright variegated leaf variety reaches mature height of 3.5m. The foliage color is very striking cream, green with a very pronounced pink margin between the two colors. **Zone 5**

**Acer palmatum ‘Emperor Red’** Also called Emperor I. Similar to and possibly an improvement of Bloodgood, retaining its purple-red leaf color even better through the growing season. Changes to dark crimson in the fall. Leaves are thinner in texture than Bloodgood. Mature height is 3m. **Zone 5**

**Acer palmatum ‘Suminagashi’** Amazing color dominates this selection. An upright dwarf that grows 6-8feet. The spring growth is red and green, turning to reddish in mid summer and crimson red in fall. **Zone 5**

**Acer palmatum ‘Villa Taranto’** This compact variety starts blooming in April. Leaves emerge reddish-purple with reddish purple flowers in spring; golden orange in fall. Mature 6-10 feet. **Zone 5**

**Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Crimson Queen’** Queen of all Japanese maples, Crimson Queen makes a choice cascading mound with multiple layers and an interesting twisted trunk. Holds its deep color very well into hot weather. The lacey leaves turn bright scarlet in the fall. Mature height 5’-6.’ **Zone 5**

**Acer palmatum dissectum ‘Red Dragon’** It is a weeping and mounding variety. Red leaves in spring, bronzy green in summer. Red in fall. Red Dragon is very similar to ‘Inaba Shidare.’ Mature height is 3m in rounded form. **Zone 5**

**Acorus gramineus ‘Vaiegatus’** This aquatic perennial is semi-evergreen and showy, with grassy, striped foliage that reaches less than 1 foot tall. The species is native to East Asia. Use it in garden. White-and-green striped grassy leaves. Height 12in. **Zone 10**

**Agapanthus 'Storm Cloud' (Dark Blue Agapanthus)** - This agapanthus produces luxurious green foliage that tinges red in the winter months. In summer appear the large umbels of deep blue flowers that rise far above the foliage on 3-4 foot tall blackish stems in summer. **Zone 9**

**Agapanthus 'Black Pantha'** This variety has black flowers buds bursting into large flower heads with deep skirt. 'Black Pantha' is a combination of color and beauty. **Zone 9**

**Amelanchier grandiflora 'Autumn Brilliance'** White flowers start blooming in early spring and edible berries in June on a multistemmed tree. Mature height 25'x 20.' **Zone 4**

### **Arbutus Marina (shrub form or tree form)**

**Shrub form**>>Marina has cinnamon bark, leathery evergreen foliage, bell shaped pinkish white flowers in late summer that become red fruit later on. Height 25'x25' **Zone 7**

**Tree form**>>A single trunk/standard for of 'Marina'. **Zone 7**

**Arbutus unedo 'Compacta'** This dwarf strawberry tree has rich, red brown, flaky bark, white urn shaped flowers in late fall. In fall it produces strawberry like fruit threw out winter. Mature height 4'x4' **Zone 7**

**Arbutus unedo 'Oktoberfest'** Like its name, it starts to bloom in fall. It produces dark rose pink blooms and fruits from the previous year's flowers turn a vibrant red-orange. Mature height 6'x6'. **Zone 7**

**Arctostaphylos uva ursi 'Massachusetts'** This groundcover is slowly growing, with light pink flowers in mid-spring, and red fruits in fall, foliage is dark green. **Zone 2**

**® Arctostaphylos uva ursi 'Vancouver Jade'** This groundcover is fast growing, with soft pink flowers in mid spring, foliage turns deep red in winter. **Zone 4**

**® Aronia melanocarpa 'Autumn Magic'** This upright variety has dark green foliage which turns brilliant red and purple in fall; produces fragrant white flowers in mid spring followed by black berries in fall. Mature height 1.25m to 2m. **Zone 3**

**Astilbe 'Erica'** Likes shady areas; light pink, long, upright panicles; foliage reddish brown; blooms in July. Mature height 60cm x 60cm. **Zone 4**

**Astilbe 'Fanal'** Likes shady areas; maroon red flower spikes; blooms June to August. Mature height 60cm T x 60cm W. **Zone 4**

**Astilbe simplicifolia 'Henny Graafland'** Colorful, plume like clear pink flowers appear in summer; blooms July to August. Mature height 40cm. **Zone 4**

**Aucuba japonica 'Picturata'** Has glossy green leaves with bright yellow-golden centre. Mature height 1.25m to 1.75m tall. **Zone 7**

**Berberis thunbergii 'Bailone' (Ruby Carousel™ Barberry)** This slow growing reddish-purple shrub grows well in full sun. Thorns are excellent barrier. Compact form; mature height 0.9m T 1.2m W. **Zone 4**

**Berberis thunbergii 'Tara' (Emerald Carousel Barberry)** This variety has small yellow spring flowers. Deep green leaves that turn purple-red in fall; small red berries in winter. 5' T x 5' W. **Zone 3**

**Berberis thunbergii 'Gentry' (Royal Burgundy™ Japanese Barberry)** Dwarf, compact rich burgundy-red foliage; tiny yellow flowers in spring on thorny branches; red berries in throughout winter. Mature height 0.6m T to 0.9m W. **Zone 4**

**Berberis thunbergii 'Royal Cloak' (Royal Cloak Japanese Barberry)** An upright, large arching shrub, with deep velvety purple foliage; rusty gold flowers in spring. Mature size 1.5m. **Zone 4**

**Berberis thunbergii 'Rose Glow' (Rose Glow Japanese Barberry)** It has deep rose-red glow over mottled white and green foliage in spring with bright red berries in fall and winter. 1.5m T x 1.25m W. **Zone 4**

**Betula jacquemontii (White Barked Himalayan Birch)** Medium tall size tree with dark green leaves and upright branches, white peeling bark. 10m T x 15m W. **Zone 4**

**Betula pendula 'Trost's Dwarf'** This dwarf shrub has soft fine textured, bright green leaves on weeping branches turning golden yellow in fall. 8m **Zone 3**

**Buddleia davidii 'Black Knight'** this fabulous summer-flowering shrub is guaranteed to create an impact in a sunny border. Pruned hard in early spring it produces dense spikes of fragrant, dark purple flowers, which attract butterflies and other beneficial insects into the garden. In fall the pointed grey-green leaves turn butter-yellow. Mature Height 10' x 10'. **Zone 5**

**Buxus microphylla 'Winter Gem'** this evergreen shrub has dark green foliage all year round. Hardest of all Buxus microphylla varieties. 1.25m T x 1m W. **Zone 4**

**Buxus sempervirens 'Green Velvet'** this evergreen shrub retains its velvety foliage throughout winter. Great choice for low hedges. 1m T x 1.25m W. **zone 4**

**Buxus sempervirens 'Suffruticosa'** Very slow dense, mounded growth distinguishes shrub. An evergreen preferring partial shade and excellent drainage, it develops finely textured leaves that may develop orange-green cast in winter. 1m T x 1.5m W. **Zone 5**

**Calamagrostis acutiflora 'Karl Foerster'** Rich green clump forming evergreen grass with rigidly erect stems with Pink tinged flowers emerge in spring above foliage and retain till winter. 1m T x 75cm W. **Zone 3**

**Callicarpa bodinieri 'Profusion'** A deciduous shrub with purple flowers followed by violet purple berries. 2m T x 2.5m W. **Zone 5**

**Calluna vulgaris 'Kinrochruel'** Large double white flowers from August to September; provides color all year round. 40cm x 60cm **Zone 4**

**Calluna vulgaris 'Ruby Slinger'** Beautiful white flowers appear on bright green foliage which turns yellow in spring. Blooms August to October. 40cm x 60cm **Zone 4**

**Calluna vulgaris 'Spring Torch'** Medium green foliage that turns red and pink in spring with mauve flowers from August to October. 40cm x 60cm. **Zone 4**

**Carex buchananii** Clumping perennial grass with a rigid vase shaped form and red brown foliage that lasts almost all year. Prefers partial shade and good drainage. 30cm T/ **Zone 7**

**Carex comans 'Bronze Form'** This interesting sedge forms dense tussocks of narrow, bronze-brown leaves. The small inconspicuous flowers are borne in summer over its evergreen foliage. It will benefit from a tidy up in the spring to remove any dead foliage and encourage new growth. 30cm **Zone 7**

**Carex morrowi 'Frosty Curls'** Evergreen clumping frosty whitish green color of foliage. It is important to provide this grass with ample water, but will drained soil. Mature height 30cm T. **Zone 4**

**Carex morrowi 'Evergold'** Gorgeous yellow foliage in the centre and green on the outside. Prefers partial shade. 30cm T. **Zone 6**

**Carex morrowi 'Ice Dance'** Evergreen sedge with green stiff leaves with wide white margins. Brownish flower spikes in late spring. 30cm T. **Zone 5**

**Ceanothus impressus 'Victoria'** A glossy dark green foliage with striking deep bluish-lilac flowers from late spring to early summer. 1m **Zone 7**

**Chamaecyparis nootkatensis 'Pendula'** This beautiful specimen weeping tree has soft, pendulous blue green foliage. Reaches 40' in height. **Zone 4**

**Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Koster'** Dwarf cypress with small green forms foliage. The foliage sprays are cupped and grow in a layered manner. The winter color is delight full bronze. Prefers shade. 2m T. **Zone 5**

**Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Filifera'** Sawara cypress cultivar that is noted for its drooping golden yellow, weeping, thread-like foliage. This is a dense, semi-dwarf, evergreen shrub; slow growing, often reaching only 6-7' tall in 20 years. Small cones appear only on mature plants. Peeling, reddish-brown bark develops on mature branches. **Zone 5**

**Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Sungold'** Evergreen weeping shrub has gold-tipped, thread like foliage creating a very interesting texture. Mature height 4'T x 12'W. **Zone 4**

**Cornus alba 'Bud's Yellow'** Attractive shrub with dark green foliage in summer turning yellow in fall. Very small yellowish white flowers bloom in late spring. 2m T. **Zone 2**

**Cornus alba 'Elegantissima'** Brings year round interest to the landscape, in winter the stems turn bright red. Variegated leaves in spring until fall. Flowers from May all throughout summer followed by white with tints of blue and green berries. 2m T. **Zone 3**

**Cornus alba 'Bailhalo'** (Ivory Halo™) Compact with green and cream variegated leaves and white blooms in summer, red twigs stand out in winter. Mature height 1.75mT x 2.5mW. **Zone 2**

**Cornus alba 'Sibirica Variegata'** From spring to autumn, it has beautiful variegated foliage which turns stunning shades of red before it falls to reveal the bright red stems adding colour to the winter garden. Clustered white flowers in summer. 1.75mT x 2.5mW. **Zone 2**

**Cornus alba 'Sibirica'** Large multi-stemmed shrub with deep green veined foliage. Attractive white flowers in summer followed by blue berries in fall. Bright Crimson bark in winter. 1.75mT x 2.5mW. **Zone 2**

**Cornus alba 'Sericea'** Large multi-stemmed shrub with deep green foliage that turns reddish-purple in fall, followed by bluish-white berries. Dk red bark in winter. 1.75mT x 2.5mW. **Zone 2**

**Cornus sericea 'Flaviramea'** Known for its bright green winter stems and green foliage in spring and summer. Flowers are attractive to insects. Winter colour from the stems and green foliage in winter and summer. 1.75mT x 2.5mW. **Zone 2**

**Cornus sericea 'Kelsey'** A dwarf rounded shrub with red-twigs. White flowers in summer followed by berries in winter. 1.75mT x 2.5mW. **Zone 2**

**Cotinus coggygria 'Royal Purple'** An amazing compact form of the smoke tree with deep purple summer leaves that are translucent in the sunshine. Smoke like flowers throughout June and July. 2.5 m T. **Zone 5**

**Cotinus 'Grace'** New growth is wine-red and matures to soft purplish-red; deep pink. Flowers are like puffs of smoke; red, orange and yellow in fall. 2.5m T. **Zone 5**

**Cotoneaster dammeri** An excellent ground cover; very low creeping form with large dark green leaves. Very small white flowers in spring and bright orange-red berries in fall. 33cm **Zone 5**

**Cotoneaster dammeri 'Coral Beauty'** Low growing ground cover, with small, glossy evergreen foliage. Completely covered with coral red berries in fall. 33cm **Zone 5**

**Daphne odora 'Aureomarginata'** Very fragrant, reddish-purple blooms appear from midwinter through early spring. It has thick glossy dark green foliage with rimmed creamy yellow edges. 1m T. **Zone 7**

**Deschampsia cespitosa 'Bronzeschieier'** A medium height grass with bronze colored flowers. This is reported to be one the most reliable bloomers in the descampsia group. 1m T **Zone 4**

**Erica carnea 'Alba'** White flowers bloom November to May with light green foliage that spreads 25cmT x 45cmW. **Zone 5**

**Erica carnea ‘December Red’** Pink flowers start to bloom in December and darken to red when in full bloom and last till March. Medium green foliage that spreads 15cmT x 45cmW. **Zone 4**

**Erica carnea ‘Pink Spangles’** Gorgeous shell pink flowers with medium green foliage and vigorous spreading. Flowering lasts from January to May. 15cmT x 45cmW. **Zone 4**

**Erica carnea ‘Pirbright Rose’** Very unique grey green foliage with light purple flowers bloom December to March. 15cmT x 30cmW. **Zone 4**

**Erica carnea ‘Springwood White’** Starts blooming large white flowers in December throughout May. Dark green foliage spreads 15cmT x 70cmW. **Zone**

**Erica X darleyensis ‘Archie Graham’** This variety has a mounding habit that starts to bloom pink flowers in December throughout April. The foliage is light green. 60cmT x 75cmW. **Zone 5**

**Erica X darleyensis ‘Darley Dale’** Light green foliage with cream tips in spring and pink flowers that bloom from November throughout April. 35cmW x 80cmW. **Zone 5**

**Erica X darleyensis ‘Ghost Hills’** Has dark pink flowers appear on long flower spikes. Medium green foliage spreads 30cmT x 75cmW. Blooms November to May. **Zone 5**

**Erica X darleyensis ‘Kramer’s Red’** Gorgeous bronze green foliage with magenta flowers that bloom in January to April. 35cmT x 60cmW. **Zone 5**

**Erica X darleyensis ‘Mary Helens’** Likes to start blooming pink flowers in February till April with yellow gold foliage that turns bronze in winter. 25cmT x 45cmW. **Zone 5**

**Erica X darleyensis ‘Silberschmelze’** Dark green foliage with cream tips in spring and white flowers start to bloom in December till May. 35cmT x 75cmW. **Zone 5**

**Escallonia exoniensis ‘Fardesii’** (pink princess ) This evergreen shrub has rosy red flowers that cover the glossy green foliage all year round. Spreads 2m x 2m. **Zone 7**

**Escallonia ‘Newport Dwarf’** Compact, dwarf and densely branched evergreen shrub has pinkish red flowers. Mature size is 60cm. **Zone 8**

**Euonymus alatus ‘Compacta’** Dwarf, compact upright shrub with dark green foliage which changes to unique red fall color all through winter. Rounded corky, dense, twiggy bark stands out in winter. 5’T x 6’W. **Zone 4**

**Euonymus alata ‘Chicago Fire’** This variety is hardier than other burning bushes. A brilliant eye catching fire red fall foliage appears in October. Orange fruit like berries fill the bush. Mature size 3mT x 24mW. **Zone 3**

**Euonymus fortunei ‘Coloratus’** The hardiest variety of Euonymus. Plants form a dense carpet of dark green leaves with a coarse to medium texture. Foliage turns dusky purple during the colder months but remains evergreen except in very cold regions. Prune the growth tips in midsummer for the first few years, to encourage branching. **Zone 3**

***Euonymus fortunei 'Emerald 'n' Gold'*** This evergreen shrub has medium rounded leaves that are pure gold around the edges. 1.25mT x 1.25mW. **Zone 5**

***Euonymus fortunei 'Emerald 'n' Gaiety'*** This evergreen variety has deep green leaves that are white around the edges. In winter the leaves turn tinged pink. 1.25mT x 1.5mW. **Zone 5**

***Euonymus japonica 'Aureo-marginata'*** This cold-hardy, upright, dense shrub has large dark green, golden-margined leaves. Small greenish-white flowers usually followed by round pink fruits. **Zone 6**

***Festuca glauca 'Pepindale Blue'*** is one of the more intense blue-leaved selections, retaining its color all season. Tan spikes appear in early summer. Blue Fescue prefers dry, well-drained soil, likes the sun, and is drought tolerant. 10”T x 10”W. **Zone 3**

***Fothergilla gardenia*** This slow growing round habit variety has dark green foliage that turns yellow, orange and red in fall. White fragrant flowers appear in spring. Mature height 1.8m. **Zone 5**

***Fothergilla gardenia 'Blue Mist'*** Slow, compact growing variety that has very attractive blue leaves. 1mT x 1mW. **Zone 5**

***Fothergilla major 'Mount Airy'*** Evergreen shrub known for its yellow, orange and red fall foliage. White fragrant flowers bloom in April and dark green foliage. 6cmT x 10cmW. **Zone 5**

***Gaultheria procumbens*** This part shade loving ground cover has tough, leathery, shiny dark green leaves. Small pinkish white, urn shaped flowers in spring are followed by scarlet edible fruit. New growth is light green with wine tinge while foliage has a purplish tinge in fall. **Zone 4**

***Gaultheria shallon*** Sala, an evergreen shrub native to the Pacific Northwest, forms a thick patch of large green, leathery leaves with pale-pink flowers in spring which are followed by edible black berries in the fall cherished by birds. 1m **Zone 5**

***Genenista pilsoa 'Vancouver Gold'*** A showy ground cover with bright green foliage during spring and summer. Rich golden yellow pea like flowers create a stunning display. Prefers a sunny or partly shaded areas. Will tolerate very hot and dry positions and poor soils. 20cmT x 1mW. **Zone 5**

***Hebe buxifolia*** A dense round bushy shrub that has tiny round dark green foliage with small white flowers that appear in June throughout July. 1mT x 60cmW. **Zone 8**

***Hebe Carl Teschner*** A shrub with heavy branches, small green leaves on brown stems, large, white throated, violet flower bloom from June to July. 7.9”T x 23.10cm W. **Zone 8**

***Helictotrichon sempervirens 'Saphirsprudel'*** Tall blue gray evergreen grass from Europe is one of the most popular grasses. The flower spikes are erect and held high above the foliage in summer. Water occasional and can be planted in full sun to light shade. Height 60cmT. **Zone 4**

***Helleborus orientalis 'Blue Lady'*** Deep purple-blue flowers that are simply breathtaking. Blue

Lady is of the finest low growing, early flowering plants. The hybrids Hellebores are easy to grow, requiring only shade and some moisture. This is a stunning early winter bloomer (January-April) with lustrous dark green foliage. When they are not in bloom, their lush shiny evergreen foliage will remain as a year round ground cover. All of the Lady Series Hellebores are extremely deer-resistant. It forms clumps to 30cm T. and 60cm W. **Zone 4-9**

**Helleborus orientalis 'Pink Lady'** Although known as the Lenten Rose, they are not roses at all. Nothing can compete in providing a whoosh of color in the winter months as masses of cup shaped pink flowers from January until the end of spring above abundant glossy evergreen foliage. Deer resistant. Prefers moist soil in shade. Height & spread 35cm. **Zone 4-9**

**Helleborus orientalis 'White Lady Spotted'** A hardy perennial which has leathery green foliage and white flowers with red/maroon spots in the centers which appear from late winter/early spring. Deer-insect disease resistant and tolerant of heat and humidity. Mature size 50cmH x 60cm W. **Zone 4**

**Helleborus orientalis 'Yellow Lady'** Creamy yellow petals with dark red marking bloom from February to April. Glossy dark green foliage, part to full shade, rich will drained soil. Deer resistant. 45cmH x 60cmW. **Zone 5**

**Hemerocallis** thrive in full sun to partial shade and require at least six hour of sun a day in order to thrive and bloom. Daylilies do well under tall trees, such as pines, where they get strong but filtered sunlight. Pastel shades can take more sun than the reds and purples, which can fade, bleed, or change colors in the sun. All throughout summer vivid and eye catching blooms rest on stems with bright green foliage that resembles tall, sharp blades of grass.

**Catherine Woodbery** Fragrant light lilac pink flowers and yellow throat. Re-blooms from July to August. **Zone 2**

**Happy Returns** Dwarf variety with lemon yellow flowers from early summer to early fall. **Zone 3**

**Joan Senior** Most popular white ruffled flowers with lime green throat. Re-bloomer from mid summer to early fall. **Zone 4**

**Masquerade** Cream with dark purple eye zone above green throat. Blooms from June with some repeats. Edible petals. **Zone 3**

**Purple Waters** deep purple-plum ruffled flowers with yellow throat re-bloom from late June to med July. **Zone 2**

**South Seas** Unique coral pink ruffled flowers with deep red coral band above a small yellow green throat. **Zone 3**

**Stella de Oro** Most popular dwarf daylily variety with golden yellow trumpet shaped flowers that bloom from June to August. **Zone 2**

**Tigger** Edible burnt orange with dark red eye flowers. Re-blooms mid season. **Zone 2**

**Hibiscus moscheutos 'Crimson Wonder'** Exotic beauty year after year. Large, shrub like eye-

catching, 6-12" blooms in crimson red dazzle from mid-summer to frost. 3-5' tall with a similar spread. Crimson Wonder are hardy despite their tropical flair. **Zone 4**

**Hosta** are among the most diverse group of plants for the shady garden and there are few perennials that are as easy to grow .if you remember a few rules. Hostas like rich organic soil, prefer moisture, and plenty of light (not sunlight). Large Hosta leaves like cool temperatures. Large leaves come in different colors and shapes with flowers that bloom in July on top of the foliage on long stems. **Zone 3**

**Albo-marginata** One of the most popular hostas with variegation that disappears in summer and returns in fall. Pale lilac flowers.

**Aureo-marginata** Dark green, heart shaped leaves with bright yellow borders. Lilac flowers.

**Blue Cadet** Low growing dense mound of rounded blue green leaves. Lavender flowers.

**August Moon** Bright fold color and corrugation on the medium large mound golden foliage. Mauve flowers

**Blue Boy** Glaucous blue leaf halves on either side of the central vein of the cordate base of the leaf are nearly closed and overlapped. Lavender flowers

**Blue Mammoth** Light blue leaves. Lavender flowers

**Brim Cup** With cupped, seersucker leaves that are green centered with wide white irregular margins. White flowers

**Cherry Berry** Lance shaped leaves dark green margins and creamy white centers. Violet flowers

**Christmas Tree** One of the best cream edge Hosta sieboldians known for it's Christmas Tree effect on the flower stalks that shows up occasionally and for the plants pyramidal habit. The soft lavender funnel shaped flowers are the lights and the creamy-white edge is the dusting of snow on the dark forest green center. Heavily corrugated foliage holds water droplets like pearls.

**Color Glory** Large round puckered leaves with irregular margin of blue and green. Center might be white, cream, gold, yellow, chartreuse, and / or blue green. White flowers

**Diana Remembered** Named after late Diana, Princess of the Whales. Blue green leaves with creamy white margins that extend all the way down to the petioles. Highly fragrant white flowers.

**Juniperus horizontalis 'Prince of Wales'** Bright green foliage with bluish tinge; purplish brown tinge in winter; acicular and scale-like foliage that grows 6" height and 12' wide. **Zone 4**

**Juniperus horizontalis 'Wiltonii' Blue Rug Juniper** Widely used as a groundcover, this cultivar will grow 8 inches tall and 6 - 8 feet wide. **Juniperus sabina 'Skandia'** Preferring a full sun to part shade location, with well-drained soil, this cultivar will have prostrate, spreading, evergreen growth to 1-1½ feet tall and 6-8 feet wide. The pale grey-green to yellowish foliage is drought tolerant. This is a tough evergreen shrub that can handle some of the thinnest, poorest soils and serve as an excellent ground cover. **Zone 4**

**Juniperus sabina 'Tamariscifolia'** Bright medium green foliage in an asymmetrical mound with a tiered branching habit. Full sun, **low water needs.** ht. 3-4 ft., spd 6-10 ft. **Zone 4**

**Juniperus sabina 'Variegata'** Slow and low growing spreading juniper with good yellow variegated form. 2-3' spread. **Zone 4**

**Juniperus scopulorum 'Moonglow'** a 15 foot columnar to conical tree.

There are two forms of this plant in the trade; one is quite narrow and is hard to distinguish from *Juniperus scopulorum* 'Skyrocket' while the other form is bluer and is more conical. The latter form seems to attract more attention as it is one of the best blues of any juniper in the trade. The winter color of both is one of the nicest plum shades of all the conifers. **Zone 2**

**Juniperus squamata 'Blue Carpet'** Fast growing with rich blue gray green foliage. Grows 8 to 12 inches by 4 to 5 feet wide after 20 years. Very tolerable of dry soils, but can not tolerate heat or humidity. Susceptible to bagworms. **Zone 4**

**Juniperus squamata 'Blue Star'** The Blue Star juniper began as a bud sport of *Juniperus squamata* 'Meyeri' in 1950 in Holland. This plant is a slow grower, and at maturity it will only stand 3' tall with a slightly wider spread. This is one of the best conifers for today's small yards with the beautifully rich blue foliage, compact size and dense growth. **Zone 5**

**Juniperus squamata 'Holger'** Holger juniper is a 6 foot shrub. The new growth in the spring is yellow that lasts until mid-summer, which contrasts nicely with the otherwise blue foliage. Winter color is a steely blue, giving the plant three different color displays during the year. The yellow new growth is narrow and arches out from the dense inner part of the plant. It is not necessary, but the plant responds to shearing in the winter, giving more growing points. This will give the plant a yellow frosted look, and keep the plant smaller longer. **Zone 4**

**Kalmia latifolia 'Carousel'** This variety will grow 6 -8 feet tall and wide with a dense bushy habit, preferring full or partial sun with medium moisture. The dark green glossy leaves support flowers that are red to pink with white banding in late spring/early summer (May/June), lasting for several weeks. **Zone 4**

**Kalmia latifolia 'Comet'** This plant bears unusual flowers that are white and deeply-lobed. It is an improved form of 'Shooting Star' with better habit, foliage and cold hardiness. They are set off by dark, glossy green foliage. Dense, compact habit. 3 1/2' x 3 1/2'. **Zone 5**

**Kalmia latifolia 'Elf'** Compact and slow growing, this dwarf with light pink-white flowers from pink buds late spring / early summer (May/June) for several weeks. 3'T x 4W. **Zone 4**

**Kalmia latifolia 'Freckles'** Light pink buds open to attractive white flowers with cinnamon brown freckles in late spring/early summer (May/June), amongst dark green foliage with black fruit, making this variety an all-round beauty. 'Freckles' will grow 5 – 6 feet tall with a 4 – 5 foot spread in full or partial sun. **Zone 4**

**Kalmia latifolia 'Galaxy'** Deeply-lobed, star shaped blooms marked with swirling rings of burgundy shine amongst glossy green foliage. This variety has a growth habit of 4½ feet tall and 3½ feet wide at maturity. **Zone 4**

Excellent dark green, glossy foliage with new growth purplish red. This mounded form takes more sun than most. Full Sun to Full Shade. **Zone 4**

**Kalmia latifolia ‘Sarah’** The red buds open to deep reddish pink flowers in late spring/early summer (May/June). A dark green, glossy leaf color will turn dark maroon in winter and early spring and will form a compact, dense shrub reaching 4 -6 feet tall. **Zone 4**

**Kalmia latifolia ‘Snowdrift’** Although slow-growing, this variety will form a dense, globe shaped shrub that will grow to 3½ feet tall. The blooms appear as white flowers with faint reddish markings. **Zone 4**

**Kalmia latifolia ‘Tiddlywinks’** Pink buds that open to light pink flowers during late spring/midsummer (May – June) complete this slow growing variety with a compact habit. Spreading to 3 feet wide and tall, it forms a nice branching habit. The flowers are very large for this miniature plant. **Zone 4**

**Kalmia latifolia ‘Willow Crest’** This is bushy eastern native shrub, which is grown for its showy flowers, is best suited in an informal border or woodland setting. Leaves are oval, dark green,

glossy, to 5 inches long. Pink cup-shaped flowers are held in large corymbs 3 to 4 inches across open from May to June. Other flower colors may range from red to white too. Loves moist, acid soil as do other members of the Ericaceae family. 'Willowcrest' has light pink flowers and willow-leaved foliage. **Zone 4**

**Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote Blue'** With a mature height of 18 inches, this perennial will display long-blooming deep purple flowers and silvery grey foliage. **Zone 5**

**Leucothoe axillaries** Native to eastern North America, this evergreen shrub grows 4-5 feet high and 6-7 feet in width. With lustrous dark green leaves and auxiliary racemes of white flowers, suspended on arching stems, 1-2½'' long in April and May. **Zones 6-9**

**Leucothoe funtanesiana 'Nana'** Slow growing dwarf prefers shade. Fragrant with flowers appear in May. Dark green foliage that becomes orange and purple in the fall, retaining some green. **Zone 4**

**Leucothoe walteri 'Rainbow'** The tricolor foliage of white, pink and copper fades as season progresses but is replaced by plum-purple color in winter. A graceful arching growth habit will produce a shrub 4 feet tall and 6 feet wide. **Zone 5**

**Lonicera brownii 'Dropmore Scarlet'** Although the coral-red flowers on this vine are not fragrant they are exceptionally colorful, and similar to 'Goldflame' but much hardier and sturdier. A sunny location and medium moisture is required for best results. **Zone 4**

**Lonicera heckrotti 'Goldflame'** Fragrant flowers, carmine outside and yellow inside, make a handsome display from early summer until frost on this vigorous vine. As with most other lonicera varieties, a sunny location and medium moisture is required. **Zone 3**

The genus **Lilium** are herbaceous flowering plants normally growing from bulbs. They comprise a genus of about 110 species in the lily family, Liliaceae. They are important as large showy flowering garden plants. They are important culturally and in literature in much of the world. Some species are sometimes grown or harvested for the edible bulbs. The species in this genus are the true lilies. Many other plants exist with "lily" in the common English name, some of which are quite unrelated to the true lilies. **Zone 4-8**

**ASIATIC HYBRIDS** dwarf selection that is easy to grow and most reliable for the average garden. It blooms from May to July with flowers that are up facing. Flowers are usually unscented. Prefer use in borders or mixed containers. Like full sun and partial shade. Prefers average well drained soil. **Zone 3**

**Lilium hybrid 'Butter Pixie'** bright yellow

**ORIENTAL HYBRIDS** the most exotic of the hybrids with fragrant flowers that bloom midsummer to early fall. Most are 3-5ft tall, with flowers that face upward to outward. Prefer use in borders or mixed containers. Prefers average well drained soil. Likes full sun. **Zone 3**

**Lilium hybrid 'Star Gazer'** bright crimson flowers with purple spots and dark edges

The varieties of **Magnolias** include a range of colors, leaf shapes and plant forms with large showy flowers. While they are generally hardy in colder climates, the early flowers can be subject to frost damage. Magnolias perform poorly in hot, dry, windy areas and dislike being transplanted; rather they prefer moist, well drained, neutral or slightly acidic soil and plenty of organic matter. It is recommended that mulch be placed around the base of the plant to keep soil from heating up and drying out too quickly. Larger magnolias make excellent specimen trees

**Magnolia grandiflora ‘Edith Bogue’** This form of *M. grandiflora*, with its fragrant white flowers and pretty leaves can also be enjoyed in the north. Reputed to be even hardier than -20°F, this may be the hardiest of all the *M. grandiflora*. In addition to contributing to the tree’s attractive dense habit, the slender shape of the leaves allows snow to slough off them, thereby decreasing the chance that leaves will break. Mature trees have a round, bushy crown and grow to 35 feet with equal spread. The flowers are ivory to milk-white, large, and fleshy. **Zone 4**

**Magnolia grandiflora ‘Victoria’** Reaching 20 feet high with a 15 foot spread this impressive tree (from our S.E. states) has also proven to be amazingly hardy, perhaps most so in this variety selected in Vancouver B.C. Showy and wonderfully fragrant 8-12 inch opaque, creamy-white flowers in early summer nestle amongst foliage that is lustrous dark green on top with a soft brown, felted underside. **Zone 4**

**Magnolia hybrid ‘Galaxy’** This hybrid is a pyramidal, strongly-branched tree that puts on an impressive spring show of rich purplish-pink blooms, 9 inches across. The advantage to this hybrid is that it flowers one to three weeks after the first cultivars in the genus, thus avoiding many frost problems. Deciduous in habit, it will grow quickly to 20 feet with an 8 foot spread, achieving a columnar shape. ‘Galaxy’ is considered to be one of the best large pink tree magnolias and prefers full sun-partial shade. **Zone 4**

**Magnolia hybrid ‘Legacy’** ‘Legacy’ will grow to approximately 30 feet tall and 20 feet wide and produce immense pink blossoms early spring. This is an exceptionally hardy deciduous tree. **Zone 4**

**Magnolia hybrid ‘Susan’** This hybrid features erect, slender flower buds that bloom in April. The 4-6 inch flowers display red-purple hues on both sides of the sepals and nestle amongst the 5 inch ovate leaves. Deciduous and shrubby, it grows to 10-15 feet or more and is mildew resistant. **Zone 4**

**Magnolia liliiflora ‘Nigra’** In April-May, this floriferous small tree, which grows to 12 feet with a greater spread, hosts the deepest burgundy-violet flowers of the genus. **Zone 5**

**Magnolia kobus var. loebneri ‘Leonard Messel’** A magnificent large (10-15 feet) shrub or small tree with rose purple buds that open pale pink. This variety is very hardy and prefers full sun or partial shade. **Zone 3**

**Magnolia loebneri ‘Merrill’** This deciduous cultivar is a superb garden tree reaching 25 feet in maturity. A young bloomer, it covers itself in late April with large fragrant flowers reminiscent of the Star Magnolia, but with much broader petals, giving more substance to each flower. **Zone 4**

**Magnolia sieboldii** Fragrant white cup-shaped flowers with brilliant red stamens are produced on this rounded shrub/small tree. Blooming intermittently through the summer, it is followed by spectacular crimson fruit. Magnolia sieboldii prefers full sun or partial shade with medium moisture **Zone 4**

**Magnolia soulangeana 'Rustica Rubra'** This variety is a vigorous plant with a spreading habit and produces a rich display of rose goblet-shaped flowers during late April. **Zone 2b**

**Magnolia stellata 'Royal Star'** This stunning shrub produces a profusion of fragrant, starlike, multi-petalled white flowers and blooms later (March), avoiding spring frost. The popular cultivar has slightly larger and showier flowers than the species that open before the foliage emerges. Slow growth can be expected to 15-20 feet tall with a spreading, rounded crown. **Zone 2b**

**Magnolia virginiana Swamp Magnolia.** Native to the eastern U.S., this deciduous to semi-evergreen, shrubby tree produces delightfully fragrant, creamy white flowers from June-September. The mature height will be approximately of 20-30 feet. **Zone 6-9**

**Mahonia aquifolium Oregon Grape.** Bright yellow flowers and rounded purple-black (appearing April-May) make this 3-6 foot shrub special. The glossy green leaves are 3 inches long and reddish when young. This plant is best situated in sun with medium moisture to dry conditions. **Zone 5**

**Mahonia aquifolium 'Compact'** A denser and more compact form of Oregon Grape, this one grows only 3-4 feet high with glossy green leaves (bronze in winter), yellow flowers and little fruit set. **Zone 2**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Gracillimus'** Thin dark green leaf blade foliage with flowers in September carried slightly above the foliage. This is one of the best for winter form when backlit by the winter sun. Fall color can include yellow, orange or red but usually turns orange in cooler climates. Grows 6-9' tall. **Zone 5**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Malepartus'** This Miscanthus is best known for its large, abundant blooms that emerge purplish-pink and turn silver with maturity. Its fall foliage is another beautiful feature as it transforms from a medium green to a deep bronze in late summer. Don't overlook this one. Prefers well-draining soil. **Zone 5**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Purpurascens'** Dark green leaves with silvery flower plumes rise 5-6ft tall. Foliage turns orange red in fall, fades to reddish brown. Does best where temperatures are not too hot. Grows 3-4' high and wide. **Zone 5**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Rotsilber'** provides a wonderful fall display of showy plumes, and remains attractive all winter. This variety has large reddish-pink flowers over a compact mound of dark green leaves. The foliage becomes orange-red in fall before turning a light tan shade for the winter. Useful as a specimen, in the border, or for mass planting. **Zone 5**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Sarabande'** Resembles 'Gracillimus' but with narrower leaves; flowers appear a bit earlier and are held more erect. Fine textured and graceful. Grows 5'T x 4'W. **Zone 5**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Silberspinne'** Narrow spidery horizontally held green leaves with a silver mid red and large plumes of red/brown flowers. 90cmT x 1mW. **Zone 5**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Yakushimai'** is like a dwarf Gracillimus with stout tufts of foliage which are green with white midribs of gold and bronzy pink, but quickly change to a golden tan, then mature to tan fruiting heads.. In mid/late summer small pink fluffy flower heads emerge from the center of the clump. These gradually turn to silver with age and will persist on plants well into the winter months. **Zone 5**

**Molinia caerulea 'Variegata'** Variegated foliage which has both green and creamy yellow bands running the length of the blades. The flowers rise about 12" above the foliage. Grows 2-4' height and wide. **Zone 5**

**Nandina domestica 'Fire Power'** Developed in New Zealand, this dense, bushy, compact miniature (to 2 feet wide and high) has virus-resistant green leaves that are tinged red during the growing season. These turn fluorescent red and pink in winter. **Zone 6**

**Nandina domestica 'Moonbay'** This is a compact, dwarf variety that will grow 2-3 feet tall and 1½ -2 feet wide. With brilliant red foliage and pale green new foliage, it has an upright growth habit with star-shaped white flowers mid-late summer and red berry-like clusters throughout winter. **Zone 6- 9**

**Nandina domestica 'Plum Passion'** The deep purplish-red new growth precedes the deep green foliage in summer and reddish-purple color in winter. The white flowers in early spring are followed by red berries. Moderate growth can be expected to 4-5 feet tall and 3 feet wide. (U.S. PP#12069) **Zone 3**

**Nandina domestica 'Sienna Sunrise'** While it has slow growth to 3-4 feet tall and 2½ feet wide, the intense fiery new evergreen growth fades to medium green in summer. This is supplemented by red highlights in fall and winter. 'Sienna Sunrise' requires a sun or part shade location to perform best. **Zone 6 -11**

**Ophiopogon planiscapus 'Niger'** Black mondo grass is similar in appearance to lirioppe. Straplike, narrow leaves are about 15 inches long. New leaves are green, but they soon turn black. Flower spikes rise above the foliage carrying loose clusters of pink, white, blue or purplish flowers in summer. Fat black fruit follows. Grows 8"high and 1'wide. **Zone 5**

**Osmanthus heterophyllus 'Goshiki'** A wonderful shrub that will grow 5-10 feet, sporting shiny green, holly-like, leaves ~ bronze tinted in spring, and later brightly splashed with yellow. Fragrant white autumn flowers show amongst the erect, compact growth. 4406 Pachysandra terminalis 'Green Sheen' This is an improved variety that has darker shinier leaves than the species, making for an excellent groundcover. **Zone 7**

**Pacysandra terminalis** Evergreen, spreading groundcover with deep green foliage, upper half of each leaf is shallowly toothed. Small white flowers are borne in 2" spikes. Prefers part shade to full shade and tolerates a wide range of soil conditions. 20cm x 20cm. **Zone 4**

**Paeonia lactiflora hybrids (Garden Peony)** hardy shrub like perennials that are showy, double and single flowers with strong fragrant. Blooms from May to June. Use as cut flowers, or as border. Prefers full sun and rich well drained loamy soil. Grows 1.25mT x 90cmW. The varieties listed are double flower **Zone 2**

**Parthenocissus quinquefolia 'Engelmannii' Virginia Creeper** This vine will vigorously grow to 30-50 feet with spectacular fall color. The large five-lobed leaves have a matte finish and insignificant flowers but this is more than made up for by the brilliant red foliage in the fall and blue-black fruit in September. **Zone 3 -9**

**Panicum viratum 'Heavy Metal'** This upright variety has metallic blue foliage and powdery blue panicles tinged pink with airy flowers borne from late summer till end of summer. Prefers full sun and moist, fertile, loam soil. Grows 90cmT x 60cmW. **Zone 4**

**Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Hameln'** This variety is compact and filled with greenish foxtail flowers early summer throughout winter. Prefers full sun and moist, fertile, well drained soil. 60cmT x 90cmW. **Zone 5**

**Pernettya mucronata 'Red Signal'** A bushy evergreen shrub with dark green glossy leaves and prickles. 2 – 3 feet (60 – 90cm) high rising to 5 feet (1.5m) in shade. Growing male and female plants together ensures lots of red berries from autumn through winter. White female flowers in late spring and early summer. Prefers moist acid soil. Spreads steadily to form a thicket or thick hedge. **Zone 4**

**Parthenocissus tricuspidata 'Green Showers'** Fast-growing and deciduous, this clinging vine will grow to 45-50 feet tall and 8-12 feet wide. Large green leaves that turn rich burgundy in fall are preceded by icy-blue berries in summer. **Zone 4**

**Philadelphus hybrid 'Snowbelle' Mock orange.** Growing 5 feet tall and wide, this plant is covered with white, double flowers, from spring through summer. **Zones 4-8**

**Phormium tenax 'Sundowner'** An upright form growing 6-8 feet tall and 4-6 feet wide, 'Sundowner' has bronze-green leaves with rose-pink margins fading to cream in summer. **Zone 8**

**Phormium tenax 'Pink Stripe'** An upright form growing 3-4 feet tall. Pink Stripe has bushy flax with grey green to bronze foliage with bright pink edges. **Zone 8**

**Photinia fraseri** Evergreen shrub that is moderate to fast growing. New growth of leaves is glossy, green and bright bronzy red. Creamy, white flower cluster appear late spring to early summer. **Zone 3b**

**Physocarpus opulifolius 'Dart's Gold'** A small compact, rounded deciduous shrub with golden yellow foliage. Flowers are white and red fruit later in the season. Grows 6-8 feet. **Zone 2**

**Physocarpus opulifolius 'Diabolo' Purple Ninebark** A very large (6-8 feet) shrub from Germany with attractive dark purple leaves, this variety will produce pinkish-white, button-like

flowers in mid-summer. 'Diabolo' prefers a full sun situation for the best results. (U.S.PP#11211)

**Zone 3**

**Physocarpus opulifolius 'Nugget'** This native American shrub makes the perfect complement to Diabolo. Considered the best gold leaved ninebark, the leaves emerge a deep golden yellow then mature to a lime green in summer. This variety will grow 6-8 feet in full sun-partial shade.

**Zone 2b**

**Picea abies** Evergreen tree that is conical in shape with horizontal branches and pendulous branchlets. Grows fast at young age and slows down with age; 40'-60' tall and 30'35'Wide. Fairly dense when young but becomes a bit more open with age and has medium texture. **Zone 3**

**Picea abies 'Nidiformis' Birds Nest Spruce**. Horizontal branches on a flat topped, spreading form cover this dense, low mounding plant that will grow approximately 10 inches tall and over twice as wide in ten years. The ultimate height is 3-6 feet. **Zone 2**

**Picea abies 'Ohlendorfi'** An old dwarf cultivar, this will form a small conical bush and has beautiful green color touched with yellow. It will grow to approximately 5 feet in 30 years. **Zone 3**

**Picea abies 'Pendula' Weeping Norway Spruce** This variety has graceful flowing lines; if left untrained, its branches will trail along the ground, but it can also be staked to a desired height and allowed to weep to the ground. **Picea abies 'Pumila'** This dwarf form has lower branches that are procumbent and spreading, while the upper branches are more upright. Leaves are 5 to 1" overlapping flat needles; glossy dark green above with 2 white lines on lower side (silvery underside); sharp pointed. Non-showy purple flowers; 1.2 to 2" cones; blue black when young, cinnamon brown with age. Mature size 60'T x 25'W. **Zone 4**

**Picea glauca 'Alberta Globe' Alberta Globe White Spruce** This slow growing shrub forms a

dense rounded ball with soft pale green new growth that matures to a deep green. Mature growth will provide a shrub 1½ -2½ feet tall. **Zone 5 -7**

**Picea glauca ‘Pendula’** A weeping form that is not as prostrate as other varieties, Picea glauca ‘Pendula’ has blue-green foliage. **Zone 2**

**Picea pungens ‘Fat Albert’** The well-known cultivar with rich blue evergreen needles, this is an accent tree. With a dense-branching, broadly pyramidal form, it will grow slowly to 10-15 feet tall and 10-12 feet wide. **Zone 2**

**Picea pungens ‘Glauca’** This evergreen can grow to over 100ft. It has a medium texture with a slow growth rate. The needles are dark green colour, which are more pointed on younger trees, with the older tree having a more rounded needle. The bark of the Serbian spruce is dark black-brown with thin scales that peel away. This tree prefers well-drained moist soil and likes protection from strong winds. Full sun is the best position for this tree, which is also very adaptable to the polluted city life. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica (Lily of the Valley Bush)** is an upright evergreen shrub with a neat compact habit that is often selected for its well-behaved and artistic appearance in the landscape. The 3-inch narrow leaves are generally an attractive green and compliment the white to red urn shaped flowers on long 6" pendulous panicles that bloom in early spring. Flower buds form in summer prior to the year of flowering so care must be taken when pruning; Pieris do take pruning well, but make attractive plants without pruning. **Zones 5-8**

**Pieris hybrid ‘Bower’s Beauty’** This variety has a dense, compact habit and bears horizontal panicles of white flowers, opening from purplish red buds in early spring. Ultimately, it will grow 5 feet tall and wide. **Zone 3**

**Pieris hybrid ‘Flaming Silver’** A sport of ‘Forest Flame’, this variety has bright red new growth, maturing to silver-white amongst white flowers. **Zone 3**

**Pieris hybrid ‘Forest Flame’** The large clusters of white flowers on this variety nestle among bright red new growth in spring. The mature height is 6 feet tall and wide. **Zone 3**

**Pieris hybrid ‘Cavatine’** This low, mounding form produces upright, white flowers that open from green buds. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica ‘Debutante’** ‘Debutante’ is another low, mounding form with dense, upright panicles of white flowers. **Zone 3**

**Pieris japonica ‘Karenoma’** Possibly the hardiest of all pieris cultivars, ‘Karenoma’ flowers white in early spring amongst glossy green foliage. It sports a compact, upright growth habit to 4 feet tall and wide. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica ‘Little Heath’** Low and mounding, this variety delights with variegated foliage and white flower clusters from pink buds. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica 'Mountain Fire'** Most widely grown of all the Pieris cultivars. New growth of leaves is fiery red and white flowers in early spring. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica 'Prelude'** Although this variety is low growing and dense, it delights with bright pink new growth and pink buds that open to white. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica 'Red Head'** This variety is a medium grower that will reach 4-6 feet in height with bright red new growth and white blooms in spring. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica 'Sarabande'** The white flowers on this variety stand out amongst green foliage. The mature height is ultimately 4 feet tall and 3 feet wide. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica 'Scarlet O'Hara'** While the new spring growth is bright red, 'Scarlet O'Hara' continues to delight with early, pure white flowers with red speckles. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica Snowdrift** Beautiful bronzy red new growth is full with showy white flowers, March to April. This variety is tightly branched compact. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica 'Spring Snow'** The upright panicles of white flowers in early spring emerge from pink buds on this shrub that has a compact habit to 3 feet tall and 4 feet wide. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica 'Valley Valentine'** With a compact growth habit, 'Valley Valentine' has large, drooping clusters of dusty red flowers that are white at the base and are not prone to fading. **Zone 4**

**Pieris japonica 'Variegata'** This is a compact form with white flowers and creamy white edged foliage. The flower buds form until late winter and then short cascades of urn-shaped white flowers appears **Zone 4**

**Pinus mugo pumilio** This evergreen shrub is dense, compact, and spreading. The branches are covered with short, dark green needles. Produces grayish black cones. It has a short, wide growth habit, preferring full sun and moist soil. **Zone 2-9**

**Pinus strobes** Eastern white pine that grows in a pyramid form with horizontal branches in regular whorls. Fine textured, blue green needles are soft and held in groups of five. Slender, often curved, light brown cones. Mature height 80'T x 40'W. **Zone 5**

**Pinus sylvestris** Fast growing pine with bluish green foliage and reddish flaking bark with age. **Zone 3**

**Potentilla fruticosa 'Abbotswood'** Bluish green foliage with white flowers. Height and With 60cm-90cmW **Zone 2**

**Weigela florida 'Variegata'** The flowers are long and are trumpet shaped. Foliage is light green with pale yellow creamy white edges. Flowers are rosy pink. Starts to bloom in April and finish in June. Great sub for "Nana Variegata" Attract hummingbirds. Grows 2'x3' **Zone 4**

**Yucca filamentosa 'Bright Edge'** An evergreen perennial shrub with stiffly upright tough blade shaped leaves. The leaves are green with bright yellow border. In summer a high stalk of cream flowers bell-shaped appear. Grows 3'x6' **Zone 6**

**Yucca filametosa 'Color Guard'** An evergreen perennial shrub with stiffly upright tough blade shaped leaves. The leaves are dark green with a wide creamy white margin in the middle. In summer a high stalk of cream bell-shaped flowers appear. Grows 3'x6' **Zone 5**

**Yucca filametosa 'Garland Gold'** An evergreen perennial shrub with stiffly upright tough blade shaped leaves. The leaves are golden yellow with green margin in the middle. In summer a high stalk of cream bell shaped flowers appear. Grows 3'x6' **Zone 5**
